We had Rich Wenslow come out on June 30 to measure the windows for an estimate for the NYS Construction Grant. The 2022/2023 NYS Library Construction Aid intent to apply was sent out on July 8. ACWC Programming Grant: M.B. Dolen from Animal Draw cancelled their program that was supposed to be held on July 14. I am organizing with several other libraries to host Perry Ground with Talking Turtle Stories again, this time with his talk: Rethinking Thanksgiving.

I was unable to find a download on the Friendship Central School website for computer security, etc. We could replace it with the Chromebook that accidentally remained on the list for the ARC grant or we can find a cheaper alternative. The grant listed the device at \$399.99.

I emailed Southern Tier Health Care System about a white noise machine and other privacy concerns. They got back to me that they ordered through Amazon and due to supply chain issues, it's taking longer than normal to arrive.
