The policies given to the board to review at the December board meeting were passed with a group text vote by the Board of Trustees.

There are three more policies handed out and these will be voted on in the February meeting.

The NY State Unemployment paperwork and decision is still pending.

Sarah told the board about a community program called Mobile Citizen, the library would buy 2 "Hot Spots" and they could be "checked out" by patrons, this would be a very helpful tool for children and adults who have no way to connect to the internet from home. The initial cost of setting this program up would be approximately \$450.00 this includes equipment and a 1 year service agreement. Board members wonder if we could use the ACAF Grant for this initial cost? Sarah will look into this.

Sarah is currently working on the application for the 2024 ACWC grant for our summer programs. She is also completing the final report for the ACWC summer 2023 grant and the ACWC second round grant we received.
